

Fishin' For a Mission Rules



- Registration is at Dock of DuBay, 4522 County Rd E, Junction City, WI 54443.
- Entry fee is \$10.00 for adults and \$5.00 for children 12 and under.
- Fishing begins at 7:00 a.m. on February 23, 2019 and all fish caught must be brought to the registration tent no later than 3:00 p.m. We recommend bringing them in shortly after being caught. In the case of a tie, the winner is determined based on the first fish brought in.
- Fishing is allowed anywhere on Lake DuBay between the Mosinee Dam and the DuBay Dam. See area in red on map.
- All Wisconsin fishing regulations must be followed. All
 participants over the age of 16 must have a current
 fishing license. Any fish caught illegally will result in
 disqualification.
- All fish must be alive to register. We recommend a bucket of water or bag with some water. Dead or frozen fish will be ineligible. Decision of the judge is final.
- You must have your registration button visible to register fish and claim prizes.
- Cash prizes are awarded for the top five fish lengths in the following categories: Northern, Walleye, Panfish.
- A leader board will be displayed in the registration tent and updated regularly throughout the day. You can also check Facebook for periodic updates.
- Participants must be present to win for all prizes unless otherwise stated.
- The Fishin' For a Mission committee reserves the right to refuse any contestant at their discretion.
- Tournament rules are subject to change or modification without notice at the committee's discretion.
- Tournament officials reserve the right to substitute or change prizes.
- Tournament officials make the final decision in the event of any disputes.
- All contestants and other bystanders consent to use of any photographs or likeness to be used in the promotion of the Fishin' For a Mission tournament and event.
- In the event of cancellation due to weather, check the website and Facebook for updated information.
- Contestants are responsible for their own safety, actions and property at all times.
